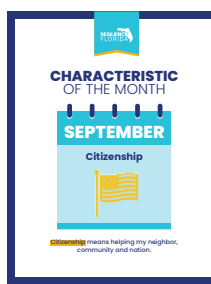

Resiliency Florida provides teachers with a printable poster for September's Characteristic of the Month, **citizenship**, which can be displayed in classrooms and media centers.

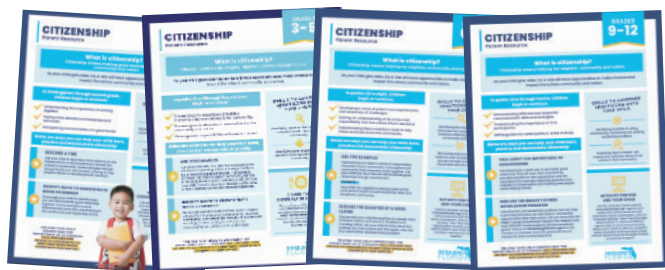

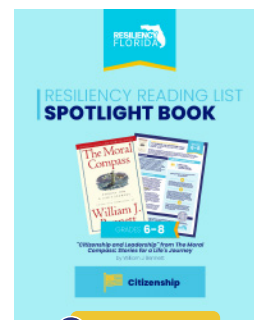

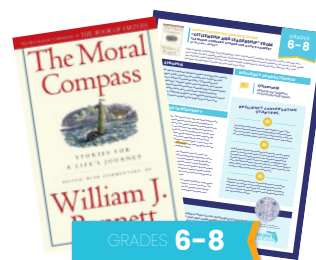
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FAMILY RESILIENCY READING GUIDES
